STOP! ALL PERSONS MUST REVIEW THIS QUESTIONNAIRE PRIOR TO ADMITTANCE INTO THIS CHILDCARE FACILITY.

1.	Do you, or your child, have any of the following symptoms?

	• Shortness of Breath / Difficulty Breathing (<i>In small children this can look like breathing fast or working hard to breathe</i>)	YES	NO
	• Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea	YES	NO

2.	Have you or your child, <i>in the past 24 hrs</i> been administered any medications (acetaminophen, ibuprofen, homeopathic, etc..)	YES	NO
3.	Have you, or anyone in your household, travelled outside of Canada or outside West Kootenay Region since Nov. 19th for <u>non-essential reasons</u> ?	YES	NO
4.	Have you or anyone in your household been in contact in the last 14 days with someone who is confirmed positive for COVID-19?	YES	NO

If you have answered **yes to two or more** items under key symptoms of illness or if you have a fever or difficulty breathing seek a health assessment (call 811 or see your GP)
If a health assessment is required you cannot attend the childcare facility until Covid-19 has been excluded and your symptoms have improved (ie: symptom/medication free for 24 hrs)

If you have answered **yes to only one** of the Key Symptoms (excluding fever & difficulty breathing) then stay home for 24 hours until symptoms have improved (ie: symptom/medication free for 24 hours)

If you answered **YES to question 3** then please keep your family home for the 2 week isolation period before returning to care. If you welcome non-essential visitors from out of the region, Question 3 would be a YES. This safety measure will be re-evaluated on Dec. 7 with Dr. Henry's update.

* As per Dr. Bonnie Henry's mandate Nov 19/2020- At this time, all non-essential travel should be avoided. This includes travel into and out of B.C. and between regions of the province. For example:

- Do not travel for a vacation
- Do not travel to visit friends or family outside of your household or core bubble
- Travel outside of the region is permitted for work purposes/medical purposes (i.e. considered essential.)
